Introduction

This index is part of the Master Degree Thesis, entitled: 'A Pilot Project on Automated Indexing in Archives of the Bank of Thailand', presented to the Graduate School, Library Science Department, Chulalongkorn University. Two hundreds archive records are selected, prepared, modified, and translated into English to fit the UNESCO's Computerized Documentation System/Integrated Set of Information System (CDS/ISIS), running at the Asian Institute of Technology's Regional Computer Center (AIT/RCC).

The project has been fulfilled with the help of AIT's library system analyst and BOT's archivist.

Users's Manual

There are two parts in this index, "Printed Index" and "Displaying the Possible Retrieval Strategies through the On-line System".

Part A : Printed Index for Manual Search

There are four sections in this part, i.e. list of titles, list of keywords, abstracts, and index.

1. List of Titles

All titles of the indexed archive records are printed alphabetically and followed by the accession number. Users wishing to make inquiries can check through this section by locating for the titles that sound to serve their needs. The titles are followed by the accession number which can then be referred to the abstract section.

Ex

An Economic Survey of Siam. -----title
GZ00-000112-----accession number

2. List of Keywords

All keywords used in the index section are alphabetically listed here. Most of the keywords are selected from the titles and the abstracts of the archive records and some are assigned by BOT's economists. The purpose of this section is to limit the users' scope of searching. Only the keywords in this list will be reappeared in the index.

The numbers indicate times the keywords appeared in all of the archive records stored in the data base.

3. Abstracts

All abstracts of the indexed archive records are listed numerically according to accession numbers. The abstract will provide the users with brief information of the particular record

before deciding to look through the original archive records.

1) Accession Number

Accession number consists of ten alphanumeric characters divided into two columns and connected by a hyphen (-).

In column 1, the first letter indicates the 'DEPARTMENT', the second letter indicates the 'SUB-DEPARTMENT', the last two numbers indicate the 'SUB-SUB-DEPARTMENT'.

In Column 2, six numeric characters indicate the record number within that Sub-Sub-Department.

2) Title

Title is translated from the one appeared on the archive description slip. Other titles are to be put in parentheses if there are any.

3) Year Range

Year range is the exclusive date of the archive records.

4) Quantity

It refers to the quantity of the archive records under a certain title.

5) Abstract

The abstracts are translated into English. They are prepared by the clerks on the description slips.

6) Language

There are only two languages used in BOT's archive records.

They are:

ENG = English

THA = Thai

Any archive record written in two languages, the language that is used more will be appeared first.

7) Location

Location is divided into three columns connected by hyphens.

The first column of two letters indicates BOT's building where that certain archive record is kept. They are:

HB = Head Quarter Office Building
 KB = North Eastern Branch Building
 LB = Northern Branch Building
 SB = Suriwongse Office Building
 YB = Southern Branch Building

The second column of two letters indicates the type of material of that archive record. They are:

CT = Cassette Tape
 FL = Movie Film
 MF = Microform
 MG = Magnetic Tape
 MP = Map
 PA = Paper
 PH = Photograph
 PL = Plan
 VT = Vedeo Tape

The third column consists of four alphanumeric characters.

The first two numeric characters indicate the row number.

The third numeric character indicates shelf number.

The last alphabetic character indicates side of the shelf, i.e. A and B.

Thus HB-PA-001A refers to:

HB = the archive record kept at the head quarter office building,

PA = the type of material of this archive record is paper,

001A = and it is placed at row 00, shelf number 1, side A.

8) Keywords

Keywords are taken from titles and abstracts of the archive records and some are assigned by BOT's economists. They are reappeared in "List of Keywords" and in the "Index".

4. Index

The index entries are arranged alphabetically and followed by the accession number(s) of every record containing that entry.

Ex

ECONOMIC POLICY

ECONOMIC SURVEYS

GZ00-000073 GZ00-000112

The users finding the index entry to their needs can now refer to the abstract under the same accession number for more detail before deciding to look through the original archive record.

If the users are satisfied with any archive record, they then let the archivists know the accession number and who will bring them the archives possess that accession number.
