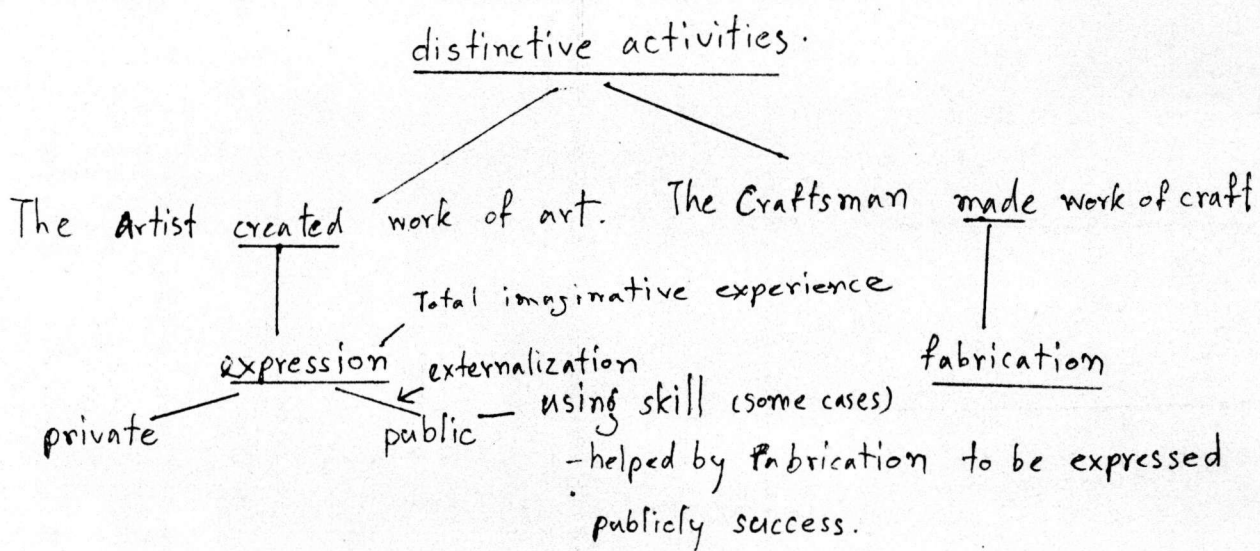
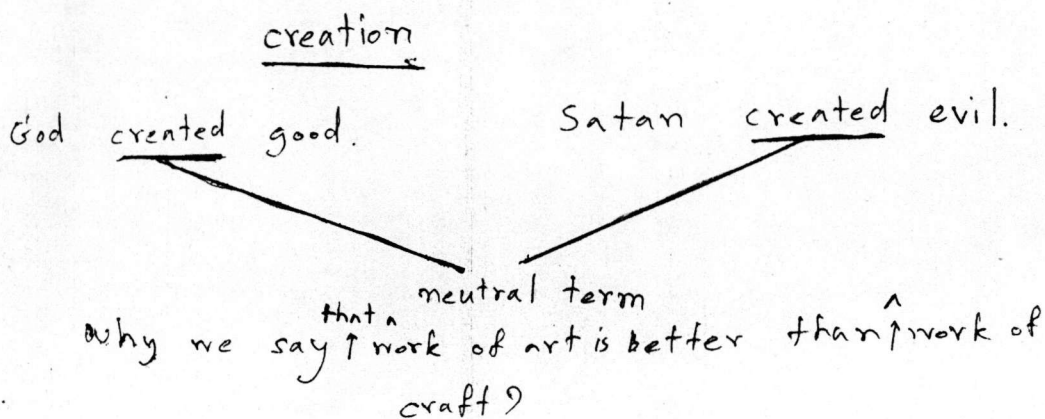

Criterion of Good Craftsman

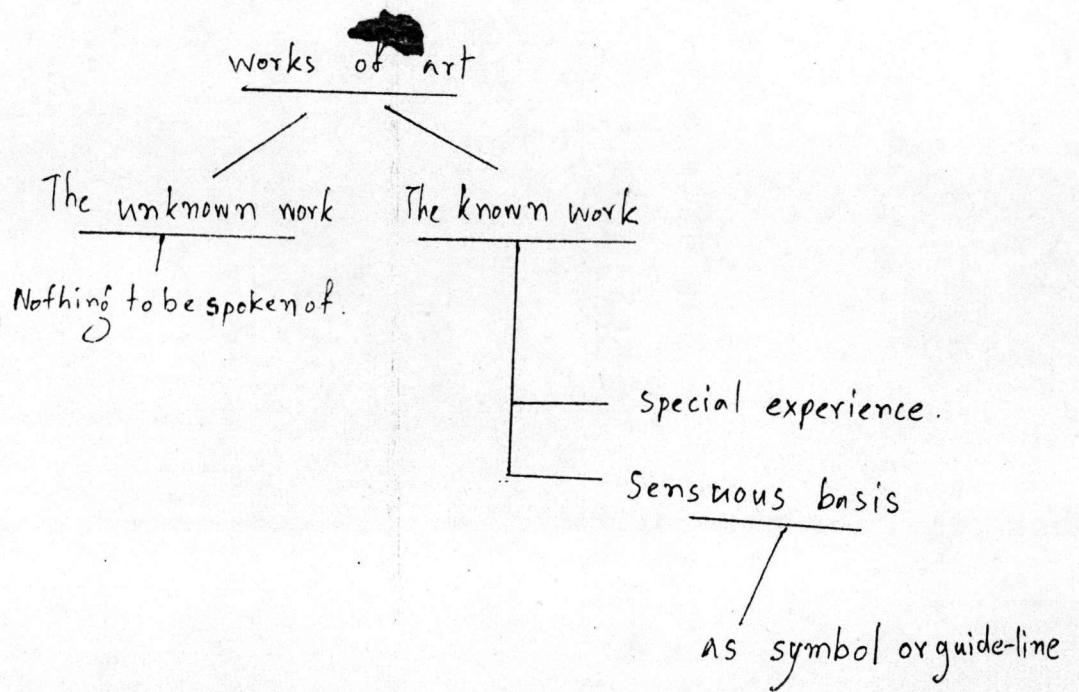
The one who can skills or controls the means to fulfil the purpose.

The one whose one's own experience is beyond this one own condition.

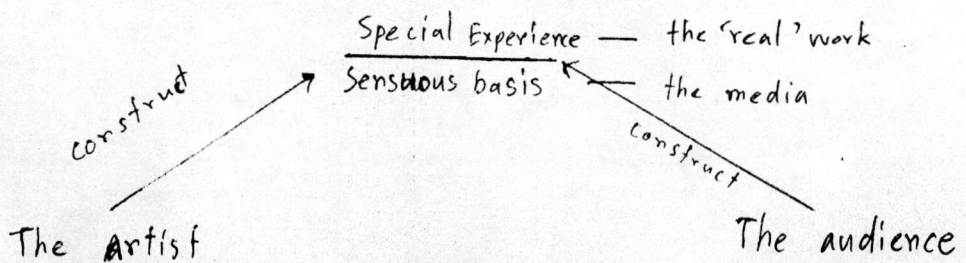


Criterion of good work of art
